PARKING & TRAFFIC ALERT FOR 7/1/2020

06/29/2020

On Wednesday, July 1, the Yuengling Center parking lots will be closed to provide parking for the USF Feeding Tampa Bay event. Please anticipate evening traffic on roadways in the vicinity of the Yuengling Center.

All event traffic will be permitted to enter the Yuengling Center Lots from the main entrance of Alumni Drive. All other entrances, Bull Run Drive and Genshaft Drive, will be closed.

Roads and traffic flow around the Yuengling Center will be closed and redirected to provide a safe pedestrian and traffic environment.

The Yuengling Center parking lots will be impacted as follows:

USF's parking garages, especially Beard Garage and Laurel Garage, typically have parking available and offer regular, convenient Bull Runner service to stops across campus. Lot 18, located off Sycamore Drive, also has parking available and serve as good options for those who typically park in the Yuengling Center lots. Additionally, after 5:30 pm and on weekends, cars with valid USF parking permits with the exception of Park-N-Ride permits may park out of their designated areas, excluding Resident and Reserved parking spaces.

PARKING PERMIT CONSOLIDATION

06/05/2020

As USF's campus consolidation plans near, please be aware that USF's existing parking permit reciprocity agreements will continue post-consolidation. As a reminder, USF Tampa permits are valid at USF St. Petersburg, and USF Sarasota-Manatee campuses with exceptions (see below).

Note that your parking permit should be purchased from your home campus assignment.

Parking at USF St. Petersburg with a USF Tampa Permit

Faculty and Staff with Gold-Zone (GZ) permits can park in all USFSP Gold spaces.

'E' permit holders can park in all areas designated as Green parking. This includes the parking garage on Levels 2-5 and parking lots 5, 7, 8, 9, 11, 11B, 12, 13, 14, and 19.

Students with 'S' and 'R' permits can park in all areas designated as Green parking. This includes the parking garage on Levels 2-5 and parking lots 5, 7, 8, 9, 11, 11B, 12, and 19.

Students with 'Y' permits can park in parking Lot 11 at Harbor Hall only.

Parking at USF Sarasota-Manatee with a USF Tampa Permit

USF Tampa permits are valid in all parking lots on the USF Sarasota-Manatee Campus, except for Park 'n Ride (Y) permits.
