## PARKING & TRAFFIC ALERTS – OCTOBER 13 & 14

The 2022 USF Homecoming events, scheduled for October 13 & 14, will significantly impact parking and traffic across campus. Please carefully review the information provided and plan to arrive early on campus to allow time to find a parking space.

**All vehicles left in lot 35 after 5:00pm October 11, will be subject to a citation and will be towed at the owner's expense.**

In addition to the lot closures listed below, portions of other lots may be closed to provide prearranged reserved parking for event guests. Parking lots will be impacted as follows:

Parking Lot	Dates Impacted October 13 & 14
Lot 6, 22D, 22E, and 22F (Yuengling Center)	Lots will be closed at 5:30pm on Thur. Oct. 13 for the Homecoming Concert
Lot 35	Will be closed at 5:00pm on Tues. Oct. 11 through Sat. Oct. 15 for the Homecoming Carnival
3A, 3B, & 3C (Theatre/MSC)	Closed on Friday, 10/14 for Parade float set up

### **Bull Runner:**

- On Thursday, October 13th, after 6:00pm, Orange route will be on a detour. Expect delays on Purple route.
- On Friday, October 14th, all Bull Runner routes will end service at 5:30 pm.

### **Street Closures on Thursday, October 13 and Friday, October 14**

On Thursday, October 13, a portion of Bull Run Dr. will be closed between Elm and Alumni. No eastbound turn from Genshaft onto Alumni from 6:00pm until 11:00pm for the Homecoming Concert.

On Friday, October 14, portions of Holly Drive, Palm Drive, Genshaft Drive, Alumni and Leroy Collins Boulevard will close starting at 5:30pm for the 6:30pm Homecoming Parade. Roadways will reopen after the parade has passed and roads are clear. Please plan alternate travel routes on campus to avoid these areas on Friday evening.

We recommend parking in the Beard or Laurel parking garages, which both offer convenient Bull Runner shuttle service to buildings around the impacted areas. Lots 18B and 18T, located off Sycamore Drive, may also serve as good parking lot options for those who typically park in the Yuengling Center lots.
