

## **Requirements for USF Drivers**

Anyone providing transportation for school/center activities must have a valid Florida driver's license and his/her own automobile liability insurance with limits of <u>at least</u> \$100,000 bodily injury for each person and \$300,000 bodily injury for each accident, and property damage liability limit of \$50,000. The vehicle to be used must be in safe operating condition and occupancy must not exceed the maximum number of occupants for that vehicle.
