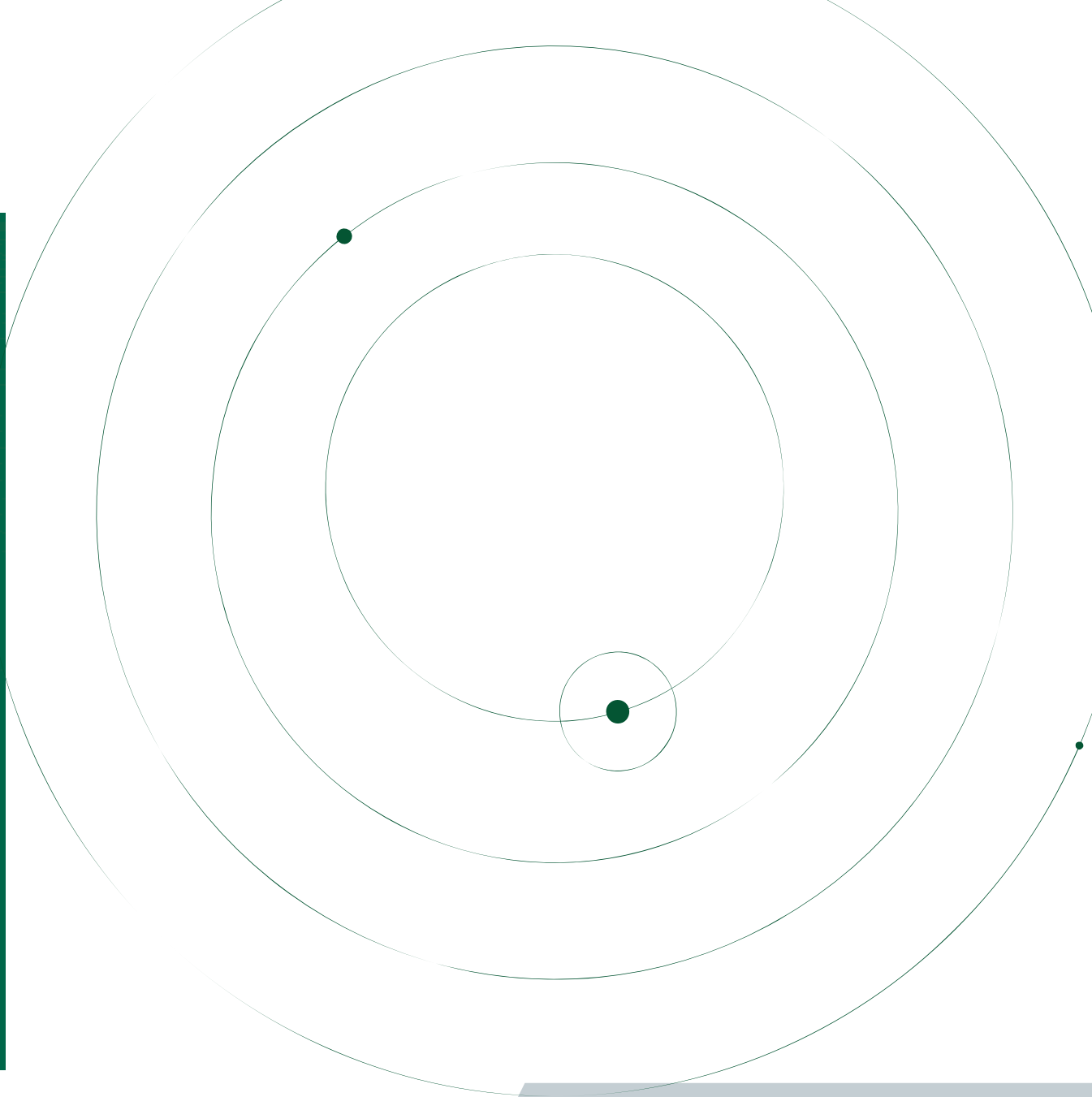

USF Travel update

- International travel for business and study abroad is permitted
- COVID-19 situation remains fluid and that each country may have different rules and expectations
- GRAC will consider COVID-19 related conditions when reviewing requests for student-related international travel to high-risk destinations.

Entry Requirements for Foreign Nationals

- All foreign nationals entering the US will be required to be fully vaccinated¹
- Fully vaccinated is defined as two weeks after²:
- 2 doses of US FDA approved/authorized vaccines (Pfizer & Moderna) & single dose of J & J's Janssen
- 2 doses of WHO authorized EU nodes Astra Zeneca, SK Bio Astra Zeneca, COVISHIELD, Sinopharm, Sinovac and Novavax/Covovax
- Mix and match doses with any of the above vaccines allowed if second dose is at least 17 days from first dose.
- All foreign nationals must test negative no more than one day before boarding flight to the US³
- Fully vaccinated inbound travelers do not need to quarantine but must test 3-5 days after arrival



US Citizens and Permanent Residents

- Allowed to enter the US irrespective of vaccination status
- Required to test negative no more than 1 day before flight to the US
- US allows Verified Rapid Antigen Home Test by Abbott BinaxNOW™
- Purchase from [Optum Store](#) and carry with you to your destination
- Verified through eHealth Visit
- Fully Vaccinated inbound travelers do not need to quarantine but must test 3-5 days after arrival and monitor for symptoms
- Unvaccinated must quarantine for a minimum of 5 days with a negative test 3-5 days after arrival and self-monitor for symptoms

Tax Season

- Students and scholars who were at USF in 2021 were sent an email with instructions for using the Sprintax Tax Prep Tool. This tax tool is free for our students who are non-resident aliens for tax purposes and includes the ability to file state taxes for students who worked outside the state of Florida while on practical training. The tool includes online assistance via chats with tax professionals.

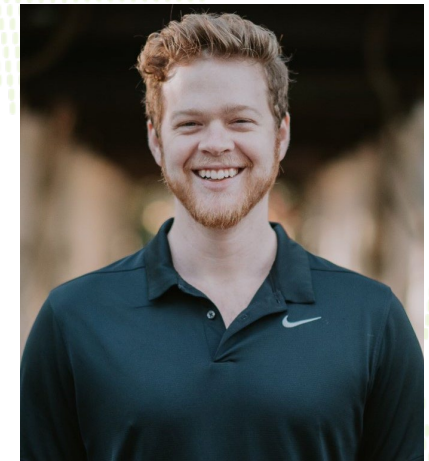

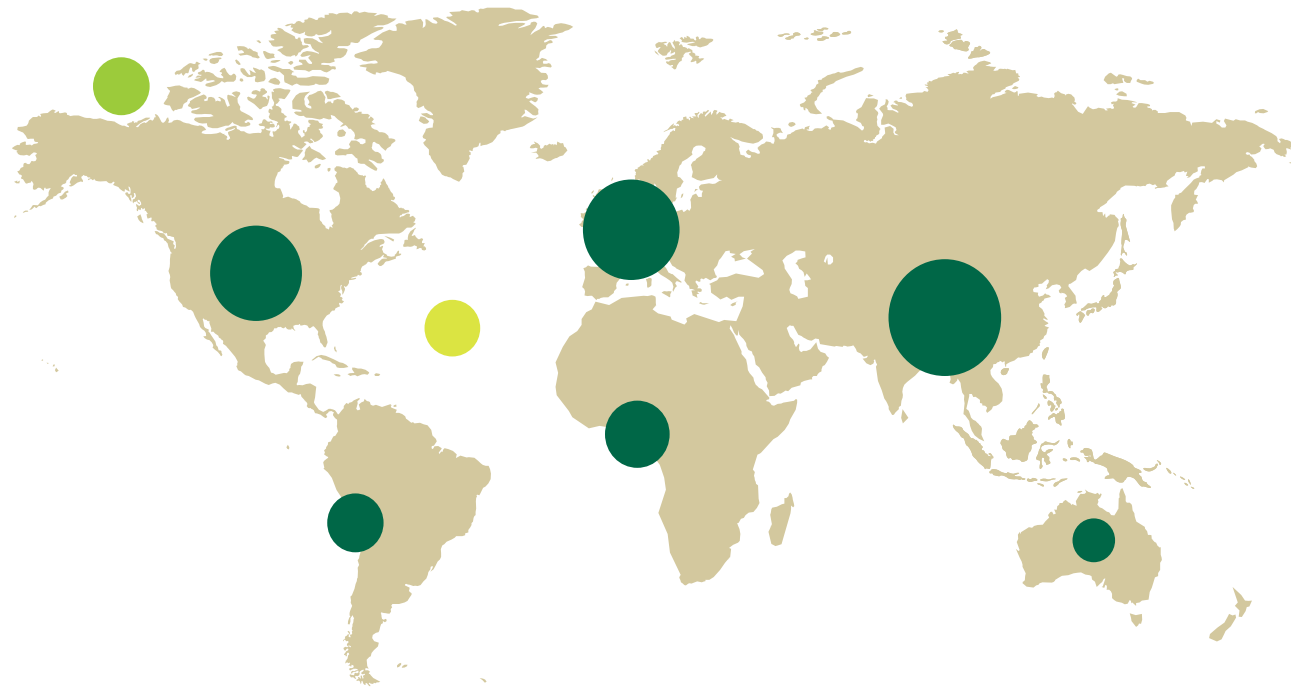

Establishing **New** Agreements – First Steps

- Engage in early conversations with prospective partners, your college Dean, your department, and your Global College Representative
- Establish your needs
- Contact the appropriate international offices for support: USF World, USF Health International
- Use the Global Discovery Hub
- Complete the new feasibility form: Countries of Concern, Florida Legislature (Florida Law, Sec 288.860)

Approval Criteria

- Agreement sign-off form

Reviewing Existing Agreements

- Audit Process

- Tracking methods under review and Improvement

Recommendations and Best Practices

- Multi- step process that can take anywhere from a few weeks to several months
- Consider the Feasibility Report carefully: How easy or difficult will this agreement be to implement?
- How many academic departments / units / colleges at USF could potentially be involved
- Will the partnership contribute to the goals and priorities to the University? Careful thought at this early stage will save time later
- Other things to consider: General Counsel, Export Control regulations, SACSCOC, BOG and State Regulations, Institutional Rankings, Goodness of fit, Financial commitments
