

OFFICE OF INTERNATIONAL SERVICES

Fall Graduate, Teaching, and Research Assistants

- Incoming F-1 students with fall 2022 GA, RA, TA have an I-20 start date of August 8, 2022.
- They can arrive in the US 30 days prior to that date (July 9) to allow them time to get settled.
- How to get an SSN MUST BE DONE IN THIS ORDER:
 - 1. Attend OIS Immigration Check In Session via Teams to activate USF I-20, get SSN letter, and instructions.
 - 2. Wait 48 hours.
 - 3. Then go directly to the Social Security Office to apply for the SSN. Take receipt notice to Right Start.

OIS Immigration Check In Session

- Immigration Check-in is the process by which an international student advisor checks that
 the student's immigration documents show the correct status, and that their Glo-Bull Start
 checklist is completed.
- It is mandatory for all except those changing level at USF.
- Students sign up through Microsoft Bookings https://www.usf.edu/world/international-services/arrival-and-orientation/document-check.aspx
- Offered daily starting July 26 via a Teams meeting with the advisor.

SEVP Guidance for 2022-2023 Academic Year

- On April 18, 2022, the Student Exchange Visitor Program (SEVP) confirmed that guidance issued in March 2020 would apply for the 2022/2023 Academic Year.
- This guidance allows F-1 students to be exempt from online course mode limitations. Continuing students can take any mode of delivery and incoming students need to take at least one 3 credit in person course.


