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## Checklist of Items for Visa Renewal

	Contact the U.S. Embassy to set an appointment and to determine the procedures for visa application. (Please see: <a href="http://usembassy.state.gov/">http://usembassy.state.gov/</a> for a current list of all U.S. Embassies and Consulates).
	Complete the on-line form, DS-160. It can be found at <a href="https://ceac.state.gov/genniv/">https://ceac.state.gov/genniv/</a> .
	Digital Passport style photos. Information can be found on the U.S. Embassy's website regarding the requirements for digital photos.
	Documentation proving ties to your home country (I.e. Letter from future employer, Proof of property ownership, etc.)
	Receipt for the visa application fee.
	Receipt for the SEVIS fee. (For more information on the SEVIS fee, please see <a href="https://www.fmjfee.com">www.fmjfee.com</a> )
DS-2	SEVIS I-20 or DS-2019 signed by an International Services Advisor E: IF YOUR SOURCE OF FUNDING HAS CHANGED SINCE YOUR LAST I-20 OR 2019 WAS ISSUED, YOU WILL NEED TO REQUEST A NEW IMMIGRATION CUMENT WITH UPDATED FINANCES.
	Proof of Finances
	Valid Passport
	Copy of your transcripts (F-1 or J-1 Students)
	Letter of Enrollment (Students)
	Letter from your academic department explaining the type of research that you are doing, if you are a graduate student engaged in a thesis option or in writing
