4)	Dean's remarks	 Dean Eisenberg presented to Faculty Council: Met with Elizabeth Hordge-Freeman and looking into a new role within CAS for an Associate Dean of Diversity to increase its DEI efforts in CAS. Was brought up that with this role and the proposed legislation, it could possibly be dismantled or considered "illegal" in accordance with the proposed legislation. Will seek advice from Diversity Committee when they meet November 30, 2021. The Strategic Plan will be voted on Monday, November 22, 2021 at the Board of Trustees meeting. Will go into effect sometime in January of next year. Interim President Rhea Law has done a great job in changing the culture at USF and "recognizing the reality". Dean Eisenberg met with VP of Human Resources and discussed talent retention and compensation are key to retaining talent. Staff compensation increases have gone into place but Faculty compensation increases will need to be approved by CBA/UFF. Chantale brought up Tuition exchange for dependents of Faculty.
