The CAS Core Facilities Committee met once this semester and now consists of core facility managers assisted by Kevin Williams of the CAS-ADR's office. We are currently identifying high end users of the facility who share vested interest in promotion and long-term sustainability of CAS Core facilities and are able to serve on the committee going forward.
