I am aiming to make an immersive painting-based experience that discusses issues of flatness and image-based content that are at the forefront of critical discourse in painting at the moment. This is an opportunity to further my current research interests in a space of progressive thought and activity during the contemporary art world's biggest gathering of the year, with a highly critical national and international audience of curators, critics, and collectors.
