Nev Jones, PhD, is an Assistance Professor in the Department of Mental Health Law and Policy and faculty affiliate with the Louis de la Parte Florida Mental Health Institute. She also holds an (affiliate) clinical faculty appointment with the Yale University School of Medicine’s Program for Recovery & Community Health. Dr. Jones received her Ph.D. from DePaul University in 2014, followed by a postdoctoral fellowship at Stanford University in medical anthropology and psychiatry.

Nev Jones, PhD, is a community psychologist by training and currently an assistant professor of mental health law and policy at the University of South Florida and (affiliate) clinical assistant professor of psychiatry at the Yale University School of Medicine. Major areas of expertise include early psychosis, youth/young adult mental health services more broadly, and recovery in serious mental illness. Following her doctoral studies, she completed a postdoctoral fellowship in psychiatry and medical anthropology and Stanford University, then worked for the State of California as acting consulting psychologist for the Mental Health Services Oversight and Accountability Commission, and policy lead over California's statewide "prevention and early intervention" and innovations funding streams. She then moved into the role of director of research and evaluation at the Felton Institute in San Francisco, overseeing behavioral health services evaluation and quality improvement across four counties, with a focus on early intervention for both first episode and clinical high-risk youth.
