

Vishwa Alapathy receives International Travel Award



Vishwa Alapathy, a doctoral candidate in the Department of Electrical Engineering and student researcher with the C4ISI Military & Intelligence Defense Laboratory, has been awarded an International travel grant from the Office of Graduate Studies, 2018. These grants are available for graduate students to present their work at an International Conference.
