The USF Pearls program offers a student centered strengths-based approach with the student's holistic well-being as a key focus.

Program staff provides education, advocacy and collaboration with campus and community partners to assist students emerging from foster care through:

- Individualized Support

 Each Pearl will have a dedicated support coordinator.
- Mentorship Each Pearl will be assigned a mentor (faculty, staff, or alumni).
- Programming
 Pearls will be invited to goal-oriented programs with skill building learning objectives.
- Pearls will have access to both campus and community resources for needs that may arise.



PROGRAM HISTORY

In 2020, the USF Pearls program began as St. Pete Pearls on the St. Petersburg campus, which is known for its nautical atmosphere along with being within driving distance of our beautiful Gulf Coast beaches. One of the most precious treasures that the ocean creates is a pearl. Just as the pearl is impacted by the environmental factors that contribute to its existence, so do our students who have had experience in foster care. Our goal is to cultivate each pearl to thrive at USF. The program that initially served 36 students has now expanded to serve over 250 students on all three campuses.
