


2021 - 2022 Annual Report




All information represents retention data from the 2021-2022 academic year. GPA data reflects average GPA for all enrolled students as of Jan 2023.


GENDER COMPOSITION AT FCS PARTNERS




GENDER COMPOSITION AT USF
