




5th TECO cohort started in the spring. 65 BGS and BSAS degrees were awarded with a concentration in leadership and change management to our TECO students.





GRANTS RECEIVED:

Office of Veteran Success was awarded the 2021 U.S. Department of Education Centers of Excellence for Veteran Student Success grant totaling \$437,469.

Upward Bound program renewed their grant with the U.S. Department of Education for **\$824,000** over four years totaling \$4.1 million.

The Lumina Foundation granted the Florida Consortium of Metropolitan Research Universities **\$400,000**. This grant will allow the Office of Transfer Student Success to elevate transfer success.
