CAMPUS INFORMATION CENTER (CIC) DRIVE-THRU REOPENING

PARKING PERMITS VALID ON ALL CAMPUSES

As USF's campus consolidation plans near, please be aware that USF's existing parking permit reciprocity agreements will continue post-consolidation. As a reminder, USF Tampa permits are valid at USF St. Petersburg, and USF SarasotaManatee campuses with exceptions (see below).

Note that your parking permit should be purchased from your home campus assignment.

Parking at USF St. Petersburg with a USF Tampa Permit

Faculty and Staff with Gold-Zone (GZ) permits can park in all USFSP Gold spaces.

'E' permit holders can park in all areas designated as Green parking. This includes the parking garage on Levels 2-5 and parking lots 5, 7, 8, 9, 11, 11B, 12, 13, 14, and 19.

Students with 'S' and 'R' permits can park in all areas designated as Green parking. This includes the parking garage on Levels 2-5 and parking lots 5, 7, 8, 9, 11, 11B, 12, and 19.

Students with 'Y' permits can park in parking Lot 11 at Harbor Hall only.

Parking at USF Sarasota-Manatee with a USF Tampa Permit

USF Tampa permits are valid in all parking lots on the USF Sarasota-Manatee Campus, except for Park 'n Ride (Y) permits.

PARKING PERMIT ALTERNATIVES FOR 2020-2021

Parking and Transportation Services understands that many students, faculty and staff may not be able to justify purchasing an annual or semester parking permit due to irregular campus visits. In addition to semester and annual permits, the following options may be more practical for those who find themselves on campus only a few times throughout the Fall semester.

To ensure that any of these options are right for you, Parking and Transportation Services recommends calculating the most cost-effective option based on the amount of your expected visits to campus.

Daily and Timed Space Parking

Daily Parking permits are available at \$5.00 per day and Timed Space parking permits at \$1.50 per hour. Both options provide access to all "D" lots only. Daily parking permits and timed space parking may be purchased at pay stations or through the ParkMobile app.

Daily Scratch-off Permits

Daily scratch-off permits are also available at \$5.00 per day and offer the convenience of advance purchase and flexibility of use as you choose the date by scratching off the month, day, and year. These permits can be purchased from the main Parking Services Building (PSB) located on USF Plum and USF West Holly Drive or the Campus Information Center (CIC), located on USF Leroy Collins Boulevard. Parking with this permit is available in E/D permitted lots.

Metered Parking

Metered spaces area available throughout the campus for parking up to two hours. Payment may be made with one of the following credit cards: Visa, MasterCard, or Discover. View Map for locations.

PAYMENT METHODS

ParkMobile - Through a smartphone application (a touchless option), ParkMobile facilitates parking payment via cell phone. Both daily and hourly options are available. A few clicks and you're done! For more information visit our ParkMobile webpage [here](#).
