The Law Enforcement Challenge is a competition between similar size and type law enforcement agencies. It recognizes and rewards the best overall traffic safety programs in the State of Florida. The areas of concentration include efforts to enforce laws and educate the public about occupant protection, impaired driving, and speed. Departments submit an application which documents their agency's efforts and effectiveness in these areas. The winning safety programs are those that combine officer training, public information and enforcement to reduce crashes and injuries within its jurisdiction.
