Screen Entry	The number entered (652,513) is outside the expected range of between 208,078 and 386,428 compared to the prior year value. Please correct your data or explain. (Error #15015)	Explanation	Yes	
Reason:	The increase in the digital/electronic books reflects cataloged e-books titles owned/leased by the library. Last year's total only reflected e-books that were part of a selection process as per the 2014-15 IPEDS definitions.			
Screen Entry	The calculated value (707,193) is outside the expected range of between 238,928 and 443,722 compared to the prior year value. Please correct your data or explain. (Error #15027)	Explanation	Yes	
Reason:	The increase in circulation for this reporting cycle is due to the change in the IPEDS definition. Last year's circulation total reflected only items that were part of a selection process. This year, all e-books and e-media titles were included. When available, BR1 and MR1 counter reports were used. If not available, BR2 and MR2 or other vendor usage statistics was used.

Reason:	This year's increase is due to a change in the IPEDS definition which includes microforms and cartographic materials.

Reason:	This year's increase in the Media-Physical category is due to a change in the IPEDS definition which includes microforms and cartographic materials.

Reason:	The increase in fringe benefits for this reporting cycle is due to the inclusion of the Shimberg Health Sciences Library. The expenditures for the fringe benefits reported last year (\$1,227,630) does not include the Shimberg Health Sciences Library. Shimberg is part of the Tampa campus and is part of IPEDS ID#137351.
