

Full time employees receiving workers' compensation full wage loss benefits are paid 5.3 hours per day. If an employee is on wage loss and a holiday falls while receiving wage loss, the employee receives 8 hours for the holiday (5.3 from Risk Management and 2.7 from USF). However, the employee DOES NOT receive any special compensatory time or a delayed holiday to be taken at a later date. Remember, employees who are receiving workers' compensation benefits continue to accrue annual and/ or sick leave at the rate accrued prior to the incident whether or not wage loss payments are supplemented by the use of accrued leave.
