Parking demand is expected to increase in lots located along USF Alumni, Genshaft, and Sycamore Drives. Please be mindful of increased pedestrian and vehicle traffic in this area. Below is the list of parking lots that will be impacted.

In addition, alternate parking may be available in lots 21, 22D, 22E, and 23T
