### PARKING & TRAFFIC ALERT FOR 11/14

11/12/2019

The 2019 Presidential Inauguration will result in lot closures and high traffic volumes on campus. Please carefully review the information provided and plan to arrive early to allow time to find a parking space.

On Thursday, November 14, parking lots 23A, 22A, and 6 will be closed all-day.

Alternative parking will be temporarily available in the grass lot (In front of the Alumni Center) located west of lot 23T to "E" permit holders only. More parking will be available to all in the Sessmus Mall grass lot located North of BSN. Any vehicles to remain in these lots after 5:30 pm will receive a citation.

As such, parking demand is expected to increase in lots located along Alumni and Genshaft Drives.

Please be mindful of increased pedestrian traffic as guests arrive and proceed to the Alumni Center.

## PARKING & TRAFFIC ALERT FOR 11/09

On Saturday, November 9, the Yuengling Center parking lots will close at 5:30pm and will reopen November 10 at 12:00am to provide parking for an evening Yuengling Center event. Vehicles that are remaining in the Yuengling Center lots after 5:30pm on Nov 9, will receive a citation.

High traffic volumes are expected at the Collins Boulevard and Bull Run entrances off Fowler Ave leading to the Yuengling Center. Parking demand is also expected to increase in the Yuengling Center lots as well as other parking lots located along Alumni, Genshaft and Holly Drives, and Collins Blvd. Please be mindful of increased pedestrian traffic along Alumni, Genshaft, Sago and Elm Drives as guests arrive and proceed to the Yuengling Center.

Roads and traffic flow around the Yuengling Center will be redirected to provide a safe pedestrian and traffic environment. Bull Run Drive will be closed from the intersection of Alumni Drive north to Elm Drive. Please expect delays on the Bull Runner routes around the Yuengling Center.
