### ORIGINAL NOTIFICATION

On July 27, 2014, the University of South Florida Police Department received a report of a sexual battery that took place early in the morning at the Juniper-Poplar residence hall on the Tampa Campus. A resident student reported that a tall, thin black male she was not acquainted with sexually battered her in a room in that residence hall. A possible suspect has been identified.
