Medicine) were awarded a \$1.8+ million grant from the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases for the project entitled "Novel Polymer Biomaterials Combating *C. difficile* Infection." The project

was slated to start in September and continue until August 2024.

The Cai Lab is "a synthetic inorganic and organic materials research group focusing on task-specific design and functionalization of advanced porous materials."

The Sun Lab (http://www.sunlab-usf.com) focuses on the pathogenesis of Clostridium difficile infection (CDI) and development of novel preventive and therapeutic agents against CDI.

Dr. Li wrote, "We are a synthetic inorganic and organic materials research group focusing on task-specific design and functionalization of advanced porous materials."

Dr. Woodcock commented "Our research is focused on developing and employing computational methodology to solve critical problems at the interface of biophysics, medicine, and material science. Our two main foci are (1) elucidating, characterizing, and engineering novel enzymes that biodegrade plastics and (2) developing accurate and robust methods for simulating biomolecular systems."
