123rd Commencement

The first live commencements since December 2019 were held May 8th at St. Petersburg's Tropicana Field (43,000 seats). Each graduate was allowed two registered guests.

There were no lines of graduates to a central platform. Instead, each graduate stood to be recognized as their name was called.

Some 7,200 graduates attended one the two ceremonies, held at 9:00 am and 6:30 pm. They sat wearing masks on chairs distanced on the field and were evidently organized in four groups.

Graduates included 5,206 undergraduates, 1,691 masters, 289 doctorates.

Those graduated included 50 US states and 100 nations.

Planning was underway for another in-person commencement later in fall term for other graduates as well as for those not previously able to appear.

Dr. **Jiangfeng Cai** (USF Preeminent Professor) arranged for colleagues and guests




to present Wednesday morning seminars 9:30-10:30 am starting in late August and ending at the end of the term.
