Why Public Speaking?

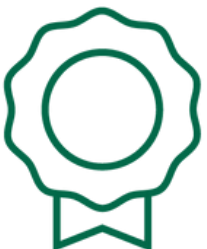

About the Course

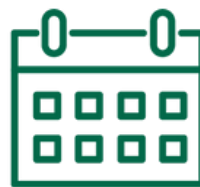
This course serves to prepare professionals in researching, creating, and executing formal presentations. Participants will develop their communication skills, and learn strategies for a wide range of public speaking situations, from workplace presentations to formal occasions. Aimed at professionals who wish to gain experience in delivering formal presentations, the course is delivered in a fully-online, self-paced format, to accommodate for busy work schedules. There are no prerequisites or additional materials, and participants are not required to speak in front of an audience. On average, the course takes approximately four hours to complete, though participants have two weeks after registration to complete the modules.
