1. "The Effect Of Access To Mental Health Care On Health Behaviors" (Job Market Paper)

Abstract: This study explores the relationship between mental health and health behaviors by focusing on the effects of the number of mental health providers on risky health behaviors and preventive health behaviors of adults younger than 65 years old using data from the 2006-2013 waves of the Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS). The analysis shows that better access to office-based mental health providers has positive effects on health and health behaviors evidenced by less drinking, more exercise, and reduced probability of obesity. There is no evidence of a significant effect of improved access to mental health care on preventive health behaviors like routine checkups and taking flu shots.
