ENC 3310: Expository Writing

In ancient Greece, rhetoric was taught through a curriculum of 14 exercises. These classical techniques are still used today. In this course, you can learn their history and how to use them effectively in online discourse.

As part of this course, students will read ancient writing genres that are commonly used in online discourse.

Ancient exercises include:

- Narrative
- Confirmation
- Refutation
- Proverb
- Comparison
- Praise/Criticism
- Detailed Description

Students will study online discourse communities through the framework of ancient rhetoric. Projects include an analysis of discourse communities, evaluation of conventions and genres of online discourse, and a multimodal final project.
