

## English: Creative Writing (CRW)

- Major Requirements: 36 credit hours total (18 credits CRW coursework + 18 credits Major Approved Literature coursework)
- Major GPA Requirements: 2.5 minimum in major required to graduate
- Grade Requirements: C- or better must be earned in each English major course for it to count toward major requirements
