Diversity research in our department



Congratulations to Dr. Kemesha Gabbidon on receiving a grant from the Southern AIDS Coalition for her project "Intersectional stigma and stressors affecting the health outcomes of young same gender loving Latin and Black American men"!

This study aims to catalog and contextualize intersectional stigma, neighborhood stressors, and resilience-enhancing resources available to Black and Latin same-gender-loving men. Findings will inform the adaptation of a stigma-reduction and resilience enhancing intervention and inform local policy.
