Diversity research in psychology



Diversity Training Goals, Limitations, and Promise: A Review of the Multidisciplinary Literature (Devine & Ash, 2021)

This review examined the efficacy of diversity training (DT) programs across 250 articles. The researchers found little consensus on the definitions, goals, and practices of DT. This review also discovered limitations that hindered the ability to conclude which DT programs were effective in reaching their objectives. Moreover, some of the literature revealed the potential for negative effects following the use of DT. Future research should employ the expertise of DT scholars and practitioners to develop DT programs that advance inclusivity and diversity across different contexts.
