Precarious Manhood and Anti-LGBTQ+ Attitudes (Joseph Vandello, Rebecca Upton, Mariah Wilkerson, & Rachel Kubicki)

Around the world, cultures vary greatly in how accepting they are toward LGBTQ+ populations. This ongoing project examines whether differences in cultural beliefs about manhood can explain the large cultural variability in attitudes and social policies regarding sexual and gender minorities. In a large cross-cultural study of 62 countries, they found that in countries where people endorsed the idea that manhood is precarious (i.e., a hard won and easily lost social status), people had more negative attitudes toward LGBTQ+ groups, and these groups had fewer rights, more restrictive laws against them, and less safety.
