

How to use: USF's Dynamic Schedule Search

The easiest way to access the Dynamic Search is to simply use Google (or your preferred search engine) and search for "USF Dynamic Schedule Search." You can also select "New and Non-Degree Student Schedule Search" from the Registrar's Office Registration page. First, select your term, and click 'submit'
