If you've **applied** and been **accepted** to present at the **Richard Macksey National Undergraduate Humanities Research Symposium** on **March 21-23, 2024** at Johns Hopkins University in **Baltimore**, you may qualify to receive funding from the USF Humanities Institute to cover the costs of conference **REGISTRATION**, **AIRFARE**, and **LODGING**.

**The application deadline for the Macksey Symposium is December 8, 2023*

► Funding available to students who present in the Undergraduate Humanities Conference

Only students who present in the January 2024 Humanities Institute conference are eligible to receive funding from the Humanities Institute towards the Symposium

► First-time presenters prioritized

Due to limited funding, students who have previously received funding for the JHU Macksey Symposium are ineligible

► First come, first served

*Funding available for **20 students max.***

USF will book your flight and lodging and pay the conference registration fee on your behalf. HI staff will travel with students to Baltimore, Maryland.
