TUITION AND FEES: Fall 2015 to Summer 2016

Note: Delinquent accounts are subject to cancellation of registration, late fees, collection costs, attorney fees and those fees incurred in appellate proceedings. A student may be placed on administrative hold by failure to meet obligations to the University. When a student is on administrative hold, they may not be allowed to register, receive a diploma, or receive a transcript.

The tuition rates listed below are for estimation purposes only and are subject to change. They do not reflect the intricacies of each individual student's registration charges. Tuition is assessed by course level, not student classification (i.e. if an Undergraduate student takes a Graduate level course they are charged the graduate tuition rate). Other factors that determine your per credit rate are: residency, admission term, course campus and for some graduate students their college or program.

The per credit hour rate is made up of tuition and fees. You will see multiple tuition charges on your OASIS account with different codes. The different codes are for accounting purposes only since the funds are allocated to different places. In general if you see codes on your account that have the following descriptions they are part of your per credit hour tuition and fees:

- Tuition
- Tuition-Differential
- Tuition- Tech Fee
- Tuition- Green Fee
- Tuition- Non Resident
- Programmatic Tuition
- Programmatic Tuition - Tech Fee
- Programmatic Tuition- Fin Aid

In addition to the per hour tuition charge, all students are assessed flat fees. Flat fees are charged one time per term per student, regardless of hours enrolled, course type or student classification. Those flat fees are \$37.00 for Tampa campus based students and \$5.00 for St. Petersburg & Sarasota campus based students.

EXCESS HOURS SURCHARGE

In 2009, the Florida Legislature implemented Section 1009.286, Florida Statutes to encourage students to complete their baccalaureate degree as quickly and efficiently as possible. It established what is commonly referred to as an "Excess Credit Hour Surcharge." The provisions of this section became effective for students who entered a Florida community college or a Florida state university for the first time in the 2009-2010 academic year and thereafter. The bill requires universities to add a surcharge to each credit hour taken in excess of the total hours calculated, based on a percentage defined in law. See the following table:

Tampa A&S Flat fee	\$7.00	Activities and Services Fee. Assessed to all students with Tampa as their home campus.	Once per term
Tampa Athletic Flat Fee	\$10.00	Assessed to all students with Tampa as their home campus	Once per term
Tampa-Student Union Enhancement Fee	\$20.00	Assessed to all students with Tampa as their home campus. Fee for construction and maintenance of the new Marshall Center.	Once per term
Athletic Flat Fee	\$5.00	Students with St Pete, Lakeland or Sarasota as their home campus	Once per term
Repeat Course Surcharge Fee	\$177.94	Third attempt of an undergraduate course. Charged in addition to the regular per credit hour charge.	Per Credit Hour
Late Registration Fee	\$100.00	Assessed against students who do not initiate registration in the regular registration period. Students who are reinstated for courses cancelled for non-payment of tuition and fees will also be assessed the \$100 Late Registration Fee.	Per Term

Late Payment Fee	\$100.00	Payment of tuition and fees after the deadline. Also charged when a check for tuition is returned by the bank.	Per Term
Telecourse Fee - Undergraduate	\$50.00	Fee for taking a course containing recorded video content; may be televised or online video-on-demand. If a course has this fee it will be listed in the 'Fees' column when you perform an OASIS class schedule search.	Per Credit Hour
Distance Learning Fee	\$50.00	The 2008 Florida Legislature authorized universities to charge distance learning fees to recover the costs of developing and delivering distance learning courses. For more information: http://uc.usf.edu// If a course has this fee it will be listed in the 'Fees' column when you perform an OASIS class schedule search.	Per Credit Hour
Off Campus Fee	Varies	Fees charged for off campus courses at locations other than regular state funded campuses. If a course has this fee it will be listed in the 'Fees' column when you perform an OASIS class schedule search.	Per Credit Hour
Facilities and Equipment Fee	Varies	Fee for the use of instructional laboratory equipment. If a course has this fee it will be listed in the 'Fees' column when you perform an OASIS class schedule search.	Per Class
Lab and Material Fee	Varies	Fees assessed for the cost of instructional materials and supplies for certain courses. If a course has this fee it will be listed in the 'Fees' column when you perform an OASIS class schedule search.	Per Class
Return Check/NSF Fee	\$25.00	Assessed for each returned check regardless of the check amount.	Per Returned Check

To view your tuition charges and account balance:

Tuition is due on the 5th day of the term. To confirm the total amount of tuition due or check your account balance, you can view your fees on the web. To access your fee information via the web, access [OASIS](#), once logged in click on *Student -> Tuition & Fees -> View Account Summary and Pay My Bill*. You will need your NetID and password to log into the Billing Center. Please note that once you have paid your fees, your fee amount shown on the web will reflect your payment (i.e., if you have paid the entire amount, you will see the \$0.00 is due).

If you wish to just view your tuition charges for the semester go to *View My Fee Assessment* in OASIS. Payments and charges other than tuition are not reflected on the fee assessment.
