Through engaging seminars, challenging projects, and diverse assignments, students develop advanced research skills and effective communication abilities to make a tangible impact in their fields.

Program Details

The University of South Florida is a top research institution and a member of the Association of American Universities (AAU). The online DBA cohorts are intended for highly qualified individuals whose schedule or location preclude them from joining one of our traditional cohorts with a monthly in-person residential requirement.

- Expected Duration: 3 years.
- Total Credits: 72.
- Expected workload: 10-15 hours per week, throughout the program.
- Maximum cohort size: 15.
- Faculty: Scholar-Academic (SA) qualified faculty and DBA alumni from across USF.
- Calendar: Trimester with breaks between terms.

- Meeting Schedule: Alternating Saturday online; two required 3-day onsite residencies.
 - 3-day research workshop when you start.
 - 2-day dissertation committee session.
 - Optional graduation residency.
- Accreditation: AACSB International (Regional Accreditation by SACS COC).



Admission Requirements

USF Online DBA admission is the same for all DBA applicants. To be eligible, candidates must have:

- A minimum of 12 years' work experience.
- At least five years experience in a senior managerial role, significant individual contribution or executive capacity.
- Graduate degree and/or professional certification preferred.
- A statement of purpose, preliminary application, resume and higher education transcripts.
- Approval of the DBA committee.

Cost to Attend
