About the USF Applied Behavior Analysis Master's Program

Bridging Science and Practice in the Training of Applied Behavior Analysts

Our goal is to prepare graduates in applied behavior analysis to work in a variety of fields including education, developmental disabilities, autism, child protective services, mental health, residential supports, and rehabilitation.

To provide graduates with the knowledge and skills needed to become Board Certified Behavior Analysts (BCBAs)

To contribute to the field of applied behavior analysis by producing quality research and increasing the number of practicing behavior analysts.

Practicum

The USF Applied Behavior Analysis Practicum follows the experience guidelines of the Behavior Analysis Certification Board (www.BACB.com), which requires 1,000 total hours of practicum experience. Students work 20 hours per week at their practicum site under the direct supervision of a Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA). Practicum placements are available at a broad array of sites throughout the greater Tampa Bay area.

Given these requirements, our students engage in roughly 35,000 contact hours in various community settings throughout the Greater Tampa Bay Area.
