Title:	Measuring the Effects of an Occupational Therapy Life Skills Curriculum for Youth Formerly in the Foster Care System

Abstract:	Former foster system youth have well-documented poor outcomes as adults despite available transition programs. Occupational therapy practi- tioners are usually not among the professionals engaged in transition pro- grams, though highly skilled in life skills training. This presentation high- lights the process of the first occupational therapist-designed and admin- istered life skills program for this at-risk population. Results of pre- and post-data will be shared, as well as recommendations for best practices and future research with this population.
