- Please note that the sequencing of these courses is very important. Most courses have pre-requisites which must be passed in order to progress in the major. Many of these courses are only offered once per year. Students who do not follow the recommended academic plan may extend their time to degree by up to a year.
- Please note that **120 credits are required to graduate**, so some students will need to work in additional credits to meet the credit hour requirement.
- Adding MORE coursework than is needed to graduate, however, can result in excess hours. All *attempted* coursework is included in your excess hours calculation, including courses, course repeats, withdrawals after the drop deadline, etc. Excess hours will result in DOUBLE TUITION.
- These courses must be taken on campus in Tampa, with the exception of SPA 3101, an online Tampa course.
