# EDUCATION ABROAD

## USF IRELAND BEHAVIORAL HEALTHCARE & HOMELESSNESS JUNE 23 - JULY 6, 2019

### OVERVIEW

This will be an intensive eight week (two weeks on-site in Ireland), three credit course examining the Social Policies, Planning and Practices in the U.S. and Ireland with a special study focus on solutions to homelessness. The interdisciplinary nature of the program will include behavioral healthcare, housing, social work, primary healthcare, criminal justice and sociology. Several leading experts on homelessness from the U.S., Canada, and Ireland/Europe will be collaborating faculty, along with field visits to successful community-based programs in Dublin.

We will fly overnight on June 22. The two week on-site program will be anchored at the historic and prestigious Trinity College - Dublin for the first five days and in Galway/Killarney and the West Coast of Ireland for week two. Educational excursions will be included in the academic package and led by an Irish educator who has worked with USF on numerous occasions.

### WHO CAN PARTICIPATE

This program is intended to be an interdisciplinary program that should attract both Undergraduate and Graduate students from within the College of Behavioral and Community Sciences: Behavioral Healthcare, Social Work, Criminology, Rehabilitation Counseling and outside the college, such as Public Health, Anthropology, Sociology and Psychology. Preference will be given to USF degree-seeking students. Applications from non-USF students will be considered. Class size is limited to 12 students! Apply Early!
