This study is an experimental comparison of the effects of alcohol on arousal and emotion-regulation between distressed violent and distressed nonviolent partners. To test the overall hypothesis that over-arousal is a mechanism through which alcohol is associated with increases in the frequency and severity of IPV, the selected partners will participate in a counter-balanced placebo session and alcohol administration session during which EEG, psychophysiology and pupillary response measurements of arousal will be collected during an emotion regulation task.
