#### **Evidence based practices for OUD**

- Methadone
- Buprenorphine
- Long-acting injectable Naltrexone for some highly motivated patients

## Evidence based practices for stimulant use disorder

- Currently no FDA approved medication for PSUD
- Contingency Management
- Cognitive Behavioral Therapy

## **Useful supportive therapies**

- Motivational interviewing
- Mindfulness based interventions

# Implementing EBP in a criminal justice system

## Some tactics that have worked in other rural communities for intercepts 2 & 3

- Diverting low risk offenders from jail
- Continuing medication while people are in jail
- Initiate contact with treatment providers via telehealth
- Use computer based CBT

## Barriers to providing treatment in jails

- People are generally in county jails for short periods of time
- Facility space limitations
- Time and staffing limitations
- Milieu management issues
