Jail Booking & Intake

- At booking, medical screening is conducted by correctional officer and Veteran status identified.
- Between June 22 to Dec. 22 there were 1615 jail bookings and 14% screened positive for MH and 18% screened positive for SU
- At the time of mapping Genesys Health Alliance was the medical provider but will transition in October 2023 to in house medical staff. Will consist of medical doctor, MH provider and nursing staff

First Appearance

- Occurs within 24 hours of arrest.
- PDO males notes of MH concerns and meets with client before arraignment

Putnam County Jail

- 2 recovery pods and a pod for medical needs
- Meridian is in the process of providing MAT services.
- Care coordinator provides peer support.

In-Jail Services/Programs

AA/NA classes, Bible study, second chance employment opportunities, GED classes, parenting classes, batterers intervention, Wellness Recovery Action Planning, substance use programming, and recovery support programming provided by Recovery Point RCO including Celebrate Recovery Inside, Relapse Prevention, Seeking Safety, and All Recovery

Problem-solving Courts Adult Drug Court

- Serves 45 clients; Avg program length: 18-36 months
- At time of mapping was serving

Veteran's Treatment Court

- Serves 50 clients; Avg program length: 12-18 months
- At the time of mapping 3 participants were from Putnam County

Jail Reentry/Discharge Planning

Putnam County Jail Reentry

- · No formalized reentry process.
- At time of mapping there was plans for a reentry center.
- Individuals are provided a 10day medication supply
- SMA Healthcare conducts reentry planning for individuals that are part of their 90-day SUD program. 30 days prior to release and continues 60 days post release.
- SMA has an embedded person at jail to provide the services of the SUD program.
