# Top 3 Priorities

1. Develop Process/program to identify early intervention for population that doesn't meet arrest/BA
2. Need for additional supportive housing options for target population of crossover youth
3. Identify need for formal employment/vocational training programs specific to target population and region

# WHO of Palm Beach County Mapping

- **Crossover youth (ages 16-24) in 33407** with...
  - Serious mental illnesses
  - Substance use disorders
  - Co-occurring disorders (SAMH, primary care)
  - Involvement in or at risk of involvement in the juvenile justice or adult systems
  - Prevention, intervention, diversion, and treatment services
