Gifts

It's important USF employees know the types of gifts they are prohibited from asking for or accepting under the Florida Code of Ethics for Public Officers and Employees (the "FCOE") and USF Policy 0-027.

This compliance-in-a-nutshell document addresses common questions on this topic and guides employees in doing the right thing; however, this guidance is not intended to substitute for an employee's consultation of official USF regulation or policy.

WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW?

USF employees must abide by the following gift rules under the FCOE:

- 1) Do not solicit or accept anything of value based upon any understanding that your official actions or judgment would be influenced thereby.
- 2) Do not solicit any gift from a lobbyist or vendor, where the gift is for your personal benefit or any other person.
- 3) Do not accept anything of value when you know, or reasonably should know, it was given to influence your official actions.
- 4) Do not accept a gift from a lobbyist or vendor that you know or reasonably believe has a value greater than \$100.
