Graduate Certificate in Evaluation

This certificate provides an opportunity for graduate students and other professionals to gain a working understanding of contemporary evaluation theory and practice; tools and techniques used in evaluation; standards of quality for professional evaluation practice; appropriate evaluation uses; and impact of evaluation on decision making.

Participants are immersed in diverse, real-world learning experiences from the beginning of the certificate that meet their specific interests and needs.

The certificate is designed to prepare professionals for staff positions in evaluation, in educational or non-educational organizations.

Admission Requirements

Applicants must hold an earned bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited institution, with a minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale in upper-division undergraduate coursework.

Credits Toward Graduate Degree

Up to 12 hours of certificate course credits may be applied to a graduate degree with department approval.
