
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## How has fashion been discussed in the academic world?

Through clothing, we exchange information in a very elementary manner, such as <u>what social customs</u> we follow, and <u>what kind of jobs</u> we hold.

- We tried to apply the approach of Collaborative Evaluation Model (CEM) throuth the whole process of this product design.
- •This time, we applied it to the stage of <u>formative</u> <u>evaluation</u>, but in the future, we will also apply it to summative evaluation.

# Basic concept of Collaborative Evaluation in product design



- In evaluation activities for international cooperation, both evaluators and project stakeholders have the same goal: "I want to improve the world."
- Through our long experience, we have reaffirmed the importance of collaboration between evaluators and various stakeholders in evaluation activities in product design.



## Benefit of collaborative evaluation in poduct design

- In response to this recognition, "Collaborative Evaluation Approach" is an approach that offers many benefits, including;
  - (i) access to information,
  - (ii) the higher quality of information collected
  - (iii) opportunities for creative problem solving,
  - (iv) acceptance of findings, and
  - (v) use of evaluation results.

# (1) Application to Collaborative Evaluation approach during the formative design stage



- This time, we applied Collaborative Evaluation to product design (namely "Global Suits")
- Initiators, producers, various stakeholders, and evaluators shared their long-standing needs and experiences.

A thinktank (=IDCJ) with long experience in Japan's international cooperation and a unique suits company (=WWS) that developed suit-type workwear based on their experience working on public water supply construction projects are collaborating.

## Feature 1.



Padlock is for safety

- Large zip pocket with padlock. This allows you to lock your bag and pass it with confidence even during X- ray baggage inspections where valuables disappear for some reason.
- "Another suspicion at Manila International Airport: a woman loses her wallet during an X-ray scan, and for some reason the surveillance cameras are turned off." (2016/03/02)

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## Feature 2.



Special for passport

A dedicated pocket that fits a passport perfectly is placed in the left inner pocket. Cover the zipper part with fabric to make it difficult to steal from the outside.

It also has an antibacterial pocket that can store the mask/smartphone you need in a dry aircraft or in a dusty area.



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### Feature 3.



Consealed zipped pockets



It can store two wallets (for local currency and for foreign currency) in two zipped thigh pockets. Furthermore, there are two zipped pockets on the back side, allowing you to safely store items such as a camera, GPS logger and digital watch.

In addition to these total **four zipped pockets**, there are two regular pockets in which you can store tissues and handkerchiefs as usual.

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## Feature 4.



Furthermore, a zipped micropocket for a USB memory Equipped.

Even in the case you have to evacuate from a conflict area on a military plane and you are told that your suitcase cannot be carried, still you can safely take your data with you.

And whenever the time comes, you can run!

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## Feature 5.



- The projdct, global suit, is designed to fit "field interviews" to "coutesy visit to the embassy."
- Also the design expresses the values of international cooperation, such as:
  - (i) desire for peace,
  - (ii) gender inclusion, and
  - (iii) environmental consideration.

By using the piping inside the jacket, you can see the stripes when you roll up your sleeves.











Wearing image
The **same design for women and men** expresses the value of Gender Inclusion



Special for women

It would be nice if the waist part of the jacket could be shaped or adjusted with strings. It would be nice if the waist of the pants had `loose elastic" and an adjustable string.

Furthermore, it has a slightly larger silhouette than conventional women's suits so that you can wear it without feeling pressured.

Since there are some areas where clean toilet facilities are not available, the pants are tapered so that they can be rolled up and stopped at the calf without touching the ground.

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## ultimex

Made with WWS's own developed material "Ultimex", it is fully washable, quick-drying and wrinkle-resistant, drying in about 3 hours.

It's stretchy so you can wear it stress-free on flights or on long trips, and the water-repellent finish makes it easy to remove dirt that gets stuck while working.

In addition, as a unique <u>environmental consideration</u>, we ensure that we do not carry out so-called "apparel disposal," such as unnecessary disposal due to changes in fashion or incineration, which generates large amounts of carbon dioxide.



## (2) Evaluation (Summative evaluation) in plan.

- We set the logic model (input activity output outcome - impact) as next slide.
- We set monitoring indicators for each and carry out monitoring and evaluation, and we will also collaborate with stakeholders in this process.



## 1. UNDERSTAND THE SITUATION



- Context is a combination of formal and informal circumstances determined by the relationships that surround and sustain collaborative evaluation.
- It (a) establishes the SWOT (strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and threats), (b) identifies the scope of the evaluation (e.g., evaluation questions, work breakdown structure), and (c) identifies key evaluation activities.

## 2. CLARIFY EXPECTATIONS

- "Expectations" are expectations that good (or bad) results may result from collaborative evaluation.
- the assumptions, beliefs, and thoughts you have about the evaluation and the people involved. Setting clear expectations is very important.

## 3. BE INVOLVED TOGETHER



- "Engaging together" is a compromise that allows us to jointly meet our evaluation obligations without ongoing external authority or oversight. Collaborative evaluation requires this kind of shared willingness to engage in order to foster a sense of responsibility and accountability.
- (b) recommendations for positive action; (c) tools for dispute resolution; (d) decision making procedures; e) Establishment of compensation options.

### 4. ENSURE OPEN COMMUNICATION

- Communication is the process of social interaction (speaking, listening, writing, etc.) to convey information and exchange ideas in order to influence specific behaviors in collaborative assessment.
- Formal (evaluation-related) and informal (personal) communication strategies must be designed to reflect the diverse styles of evaluators and stakeholders in collaborative evaluations.
- a ) encourage active participation, (b) listen carefully, (c) clarify the message, (d) provide immediate feedback, and (e) validate the need for change. I will.




## 5. ENCOURAGE EFFECTIVE PRACTICE

- Effective practice refers to sound procedures and systems established to produce the desired effects during collaborative evaluation. Among other things, this is achieved by balancing the needs of assessment resources.
- This element is divided into the following subcomponents: It (a) encourages recognition of individual differences, (b) encourages fairness and honesty, (c) encourages benchmarking, and (d) encourages feaching by example . e) **Encourage flexibility and creativity**.

### 6. FOLLOW ESTABLISHED GUIDELINES

- Guidelines are the principles that guide collaborative evaluation, its evaluators, and its design, use, and evaluation. Guidelines provide a direction for sound evaluation and, once adopted and established, provide a baseline for improvement.
- (a) to follow the evaluator's guidelines, (b) to follow the evaluation criteria (program, personnel, student evaluation criteria, etc.), and (c) to follow the collaborative evaluation guidelines.



=> It can be said that the Collaborative Evaluation Model supports program evaluation as the base (=the foundation).

## CONCLUSION AND FINAL MESSAGE



In response to this recognition, it was confirmed that Collaborative Evaluation is the approach that brings many benefits.

- (i) Access to information
- (ii) Quality of collected information
- (iii) Opportunity for creative problem solving
- (iv) Acceptance of evaluation results
- (v) Utilization of evaluation results

It was confirmed that collaborative evaluation is effective and applicable not only to public programs but also in product designs.
