Note that older catalogs may have different course numbers, different options, and/or different requirements. Check with the Department Undergraduate Advisor concerning possible courses not listed. This list is provided as a guide; the Undergraduate Catalog remains as the definitive source of requirements. *Note that not all of the courses listed below will be offered in any given academic year.*

- 1) These courses are not open to Computer Science or Computer Engineering students, some courses may not be open for Information Technology students.

- 3) COP 4931 is the designation for special topic course. Unless otherwise stated, the pre-requisite for COP 4931 is COP 4538 Data Structures and Algorithms for IT.
- 4) Students may earn up to 9 credit hours of COP 4900 Independent Study and/or CIS 4947 Industry Internship credit, no more than 3 credit hours in any one given company for CIS 4947 credit. Internships for CIS 4947 must be in the area of cybersecurity.
