

## EE PhD graduate Camilla Coletti wins 2019 Green Ring innovation and technology award for her studies on graphene



[Dr. Camilla Coletti](#), former student of Professor **Stephen Sadow** and researcher at the Italian Institute of Technology (Pisa, Italy), received the prestigious 2019 Green Ring innovation and technology award for her studies on graphene. A combination of "2D" carbon considered the material of the future for its properties (it is also a perfect conductor), which is revolutionizing all fields of technology, from electronics to aeronautics, from medicine to exploration of the space.

This is a very important award given as part of a festival organized by associations of environmentalists of national importance, a result that was rightly celebrated with pride by the Italian Institute of Technology and that rewards the quality of the work done by Dr. Coletti. Dr. Coletti is currently leading the Graphene Growth Lab of [CNI@NEST](#) (Center for Nanotechnology Innovation @ NEST). Her research projects are: graphene for hydrogen storage; covalent and non-covalent functionalization of graphene; graphene implantable electrodes.
