What We Do...

- Office of Financial Aid (SVC 1102)—awarding student aid and disbursing to student account
- Office of Admissions (SVC 1036) determines residency for tuition purposes prior to classes beginning, awards scholarships upon admission
- Office of the Registrar (SVC 1034)—updates residency for tuition purposes once student is actively attending classes
- Student Accounting Services (SVC 1039)—applies disbursed (paid) aid to the student's USF bill, Florida Pre-Paid, third party payments, 529 plans, wire transfers, places/releases holds on the student account, processes refunds & checks

Confidentiality & Privacy of Financial Aid Records



- Due to federal regulations regarding the security of financial aid data, we are not able to provide you with detailed information about a student's financial aid
- Only a custodial parent listed on the FAFSA may receive financial aid information about the student. Students must complete the Financial Aid Privacy Release form for Dependent Students
- Additional authentication questions to confirm both the student and parent identity each time we are contacted by phone
- You must contact our office to have the form posted in OASIS to submit online

Do We Have Your FAFSA?

- If you submitted your FAFSA more than two weeks ago and included USF as a school,
 - Log into the Federal Student Aid system to make sure there no errors
 - SSN
 - DOB
 - Name
 - Check your USF email. If any of the three above do not match the information in USF's system, we will be unable to download your FAFSA
 - Prior to beginning classes: contact the Office of Admissions
 - After beginning classes: contact the Registrar's Office




Is there an easy way to figure out how much it costs to attend USF?

Tuition Deferments



A tuition payment deferment prevents cancellation of registration for non-payment of fees, and temporarily prevents assessment of late payment fees

Term		Tuition Payment Date for those with a Deferment
Spring	January 12 th	February 23 rd

Tuition not paid by the <u>Payment Date</u> will be assessed a late payment fee and have a cash collection hold placed on the student account by Student Accounting Services

If you are an on-campus housing resident and a USF meal plan recipient, the payment deferment due date in OASIS will serve as your payment due date for tuition/fees, housing and meal plan charges each semester

Bookstore Advance Purchase Program (BAPP)

What is the BAPP & How do I qualify?

Allows eligible students to purchase textbooks & supplies (at a USF campus bookstore) prior to the first day of classes using financial aid before it is paid

- Be enrolled at least half-time (6 credit hours) in USF hours; and
- Have financial aid that is at least \$100 more than your bill
- Check OASIS and your USF email
- Last day to use: 1/11/24

Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)

- **SAP** is a Federal regulation and must be met each semester
 - Some aid programs cannot be paid if students are not meeting SAP requirements
- What are the requirements?
 - Maximum Time Frame: earning a bachelor's degree in less than 180 hours attempted over the entire college career (including courses from other schools)
 - **GPA**: having a 2.0 USF GPA by the time you are in junior standing
 - <u>Pace</u>: completing at least 67% of the courses enrolled in each semester (including courses from other schools)
- SAP is calculated at the end of every semester. Check your SAP status in OASIS regularly
- Read the policy on the homepage of our website

Bill Due Date

Due the 5th day of each term:

Spring – January 12:

- 1. Tuition and Fees
- 2. Meal Plan

Exceptions: Financial Aid Deferment, FL Prepaid Plan, VA Deferment

If you meet one of the exceptions the Bill Due Date is later in the term:

Spring – February 23:

- Tuition and Fees
- 2. On Campus Housing
- 3. Meal Plan

Payment Options

In OASIS:

- 1. eCheck enter routing and account number. Payment posts to the account immediately
- 2. Credit Card (2.5% fee) MasterCard, Discover, AMEX. VISA is NOT accepted!

Financial Aid

- 1. Loans, grants, and scholarships will post to the accounts on January 14 for spring
- 2. Extra aid will be refunded during the second week of classes
- 3. If a balance remains, students will have until the deferment date to pay



Florida Pre-Paid "Memo Balance"
