What We Do...

- Office of Financial Aid (SVC 1102)—awarding student aid and disbursing to student account
- Office of Admissions (SVC 1036) —determines residency for tuition purposes prior to classes beginning, awards scholarships upon admission
- Office of the Registrar (SVC 1034)—updates residency for tuition purposes once student is actively attending classes
- Student Accounting Services (SVC 1039)—applies disbursed (paid) aid to the student's USF bill, Florida Pre-Paid, third party payments, 529 plans, wire transfers, places/releases holds on the student account, processes refunds & checks

Confidentiality & Privacy of Financial Aid Records



- Due to federal regulations regarding the security of financial aid data, we are not able to provide you with detailed information about a student's financial aid
- Only a custodial parent listed on the FAFSA may receive financial aid information about the student. Students must complete the Financial Aid Privacy Release form for Dependent Students
- Additional authentication questions to confirm both the student and parent identity each time we are contacted by phone
- You must contact our office to have the form posted in OASIS to submit online

This is a separate federal regulation than FERPA & different than the Student Records Access Authorization form used by the Office of the Registrar, Office of Admissions and Student Accounting Services!

Do We Have Your FAFSA?

If you submitted your FAFSA more than two weeks ago and included USF as a school,

- Log into the Federal Student Aid system to make sure there no errors
- Check your USF email. If any of the above do not match your demographic information (full name, SSN, DOB) in USF's system, we will be unable to download your FAFSA
 - Prior to beginning classes: contact the Office of Admissions
 - After beginning classes: contact the Office of the Registrar
- 3. May also affect receipt of Florida Bright Futures & Florida Pre-Paid

In order for your financial aid to be paid, you must submit your final college transcripts to the Office of Admissions before the start of classes




Understand Your Costs!

Is there an easy way to figure out how much it costs to attend USF?

Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)

- SAP is a Federal regulation and must be met each semester
 - Some aid programs cannot be paid if students are not meeting SAP requirements



- What are the requirements?
 - Maximum Time Frame: earning a bachelor's degree in less than 180 hours attempted over the entire college career (including courses from other schools)
 - **GPA**: having a 2.0 USF GPA by the time you are in junior standing
 - <u>Pace</u>: completing at least 67% of the courses enrolled in each semester (including courses from other schools)
- SAP is calculated at the end of every semester. Check your SAP status in OASIS regularly
- Read the policy on the homepage of our website

Tuition Deferments

A tuition payment deferment prevents cancellation of registration for non-payment of fees, and temporarily prevents assessment of late payment fees

Summer A/C	May 17 th	July 12 th
Summer B	June 28 th	July 12 th
Fall	August 30 th	October 11 th



Tuition not paid by the <u>Payment Date</u> will be assessed a late payment fee and have a cash collection hold placed on the student account by Student Accounting Services

If you are an on-campus housing resident and a USF meal plan recipient, the payment deferment due date in OASIS will serve as your payment due date for tuition/fees, housing and meal plan charges each semester

Bookstore Advance Purchase Program (BAPP)

What is the BAPP & How do I qualify?

Allows eligible students to purchase textbooks & supplies (at a USF campus bookstore) prior to the first day of classes using financial aid before it is paid

- Be enrolled at least half-time (6 credit hours) in USF hours; and
- Have financial aid that is at least \$100 more than your bill
- Check OASIS and your USF email
- Summer A/C: Last day to use: 5/17/24
- Summer B: Last day to use: 6/28/24
- Fall: Last day to use: 8/29/24





Florida Pre-Paid "Memo Balance"

Review detail transactions on your account, including current and future balance totals for the selected term and other terms.
