The <u>Global Citizen Award</u> is a fun and flexible way for **USF undergraduate students** to develop the <u>qualities of a global citizen</u> and be rewarded for their accomplishments. To earn the Global Citizen Award, students create their own adventure that allows them to explore the global issues and regions of the world in which they are interested.



Students pursuing the Global Citizen Award receive the **GCAP attribute in Degree Works**.
